

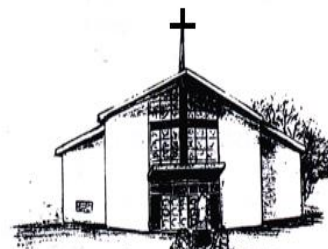

When praying a prayer like the 'Our Father' that we have known since we were young, it's sometimes easy to gloss over the words that we're hearing, and the deep meaning they hold.

When you hear the words of the Our Father from the mouth of Jesus this weekend, think how those words sound to people living in permanent limbo on our borders. Think of what it means for the 'kingdom' to come to them; what it means to be allowed to earn their 'daily bread'; and forgive their own trespasses and those who have trespassed against them. Finally, consider what it means for these refugees to ask God for deliverance from evil.

Social Justice Thought for the Week:

(19 July – Sixth anniversary of incarceration on Nauru and Manus Island)

The detainees on Manus and Nauru are in effect not living. There is no clarity or direction in their future. They remain cut off from family and loved ones. Their situation is terrifying, as it has been for six long years....

An amnesty is in all our interests. It provides a chance to restore our battered humanity, and to take responsibility for what has been done in our name. A chance also to restore our reputation as a country with a generous and welcoming resettlement program. And at least, in part, to make up for the shame of destroying the lives of men and women and children who, like so many of our own forebears, have set out on journeys in search of freedom for themselves and their families....

We forget at our own peril that except for indigenous peoples, we too are boat people, who once approached these shores with hopes of a better life.
